## Department of Colorado ALR Committee Report for Department Convention

The "data year" for Rider reporting is 1 Jun-31 May every year. We finished this year with a total ALRs 36, up a net of two ALRs from this time in 2022. For new ALRs, ALR 75 in Cortez received their charter at last year's convention, ALR2017 received their charter in May 2023 and ALR25 received their charter in June 2023.

• Over the last four years, half under COVID restrictions, our nearly 600 riders in 36 Post ALR programs have ridden over 3 million miles, provided 180,000 hours of community service and generated just under \$400,000 to veteran and community charitable causes in the State of Colorado

American Legion Rider units across Colorado are working hard to carry this mission of the American Legion forward in support of the four pillars.

• In 2022, ALRs led the way in promoting support and donations for and running our annual Pony Express run for the Legacy Scholarship fund. During the year, \$28,000 was generated for the fund through these efforts and the generosity of the Colorado American Legion Family as well as veteran friendly community businesses and organization. This was the highest amount ever generated in Colorado. This year's legacy campaign culminates with the annual Colorado Legacy Pony Express run on 8 July.

In September 2022, held our fifth annual Colorado ALR Ride on Military Pride (ROMP) event in Buena Vista, Colorado. This annual event included a Friday lunch provided by ALR 172 in Fairplay, a benefit comedy show with Bobby Henline, a morning breakfast graciously hosted by American Legion Post 55, an awesome mountain ride, a bike rodeo and an evening dinner at the Buena Vista VFW. During the event, over \$2900 were raised for Combat Hero Bike Build and Bobby Henline Forging Forward Foundation. This year's ROMP is planned for 8, 9 September back in Buena Vista.
In addition to working in our communities for veteran causes across the state, we also had ALR members rding cross country on Run for the Wall Central Route from California to Washington DC, the annual Sturgis Rally, and multiple interstate rides and the annual Legacy Run ending at the National Convention. Regarding Run For the Wall, Two of our ALRs, supported by Posts and organizations across the state, have generated funds and organized/operated fuel stops for the Central Route Run for the Wall stops in Pueblo and Limon Colorado.

We have started the 2023-2024 ALR ride year strong multiple ALRs all running ride or fundraising events by the end of June. Your ALRs will be conducting may more events throughout check them out on the ride calendar at <u>https://alrco.org</u>, then get out and support your ALR efforts!!

This activity shows what a great job the ALR is doing not just in Colorado, but in building strong relations with adjacent states.
