 - Some units are seeking new charter partners due to the loss of their prior chartering organizations
 - C olorado Post families have stepped up in recent years to bolster support to the Scouting program
 - If you have families with youth in your Post, chartering a Scout unit can be an awesome way to serve those families
 - Cub Scouts age 5 to 10 years (Boys and Girls, separate Cub Scout Dens in the same Pack)
 - Scouts BSA age 11 to 18 (Boys and Girls, separate Troops for each)
 - Venturing age 14 to 20 (Coed)


